☆ What is a "neighborhood association"?

"A neighborhood association is the voluntary will of people living in a certain area.

To make the area comfortable and livable, based on the consensus of . It is a voluntary group formed, and it is a safe and secure community creation

It is described as central bearer. (Reference: Yokosuka City United Neighborhood Association's activity guide)

What is the area of "West-Sano Town Neighborhood Association"? West-Sano Town Neighborhood Association belongs to the "Uwamachi No. 2 Union Neighborhood Association (about 7,600 households)" of the "Yokosuka City Union Neighborhood Association", and currently about 600 households are members. The area of the West-Sano Neighborhood Association covers Sano-Town 1, 2, 3, and 4-chome, and is divided into 10 districts from Ward 1 to Ward 9 B. The map shows the following.

☆ About "Activities of the Neighborhood Association"

"West-Sano Town Neighborhood Association is a community association where people living in the area can live safely and security.

Aiming to create a livable city, voluntarily formed and operated with the community as a connection.

- Improvement of the housing environment and beautification activities
 - (1) Cleaning of roads and parks
 - (2) Maintenance and management of garbage collection stations
 - (3) Collective resource recovery
- 2. Disaster Prevention and Crime Prevention Activities
 - (1) Voluntary disaster prevention drills, installation and maintenance of fire extinguishers on the streets
 - (2)Crime prevention patrol to watch over children leaving school
 - (3) Maintenance of security lights (maintenance and management is provided by City Hall)
- 3. Communication of Information
 - (1) Distribution of "Public Relations Yokosuka" and "Prefectural News"
 - (2) Circulars and postings of notices from the city, related organizations, neighborhood associations, etc.
- 4. Activities such as events
 - (1) Summer Festival, Bon Odori Festival
 - (2) Children's association events and activities to watch over school children (in 5 towns)
 - (3) Tsurukubo Elementary School District Kenmin Sports Association
 - (4) Let's walk together for three generations
 - (5) New Year's Party
 - (6) Celebration of Respect for the Aged
 - (7) Presentation of commemorative gifts to new adults
